Oman lies on the south east corner of the Arabian Peninsula. Its coast extends to a distance of 1,700 km from the Strait of Hormuz in the north to the borders of the Republic of Yemen in the South, overlooking three seas: the Arabian Gulf, the Gulf of Oman and the Arabian Sea. It is bordered on the west by the United Arab Emirates and the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia.

the 20th of November 1982, the foundation stone of Sultan Qaboos University was established as a fulfillment of the promise of His Majesty Sultan Qaboos. After four years, the University received its first batch of students in September 1986.

The University has six colleges in the sciences and four colleges in the humanities. The Arabic language is the medium of instruction in the College of Arts and Social Sciences, College of Law and College of Education. The English language is the medium of instruction in the Colleges of Medicine and Health Sciences, Engineering, Science, Commerce and Economics, and Agricultural and Marine Sciences. The University is staffed with distinguished Omani and international faculty members.

The academic year consists of two regular semesters: autumn and spring, each totaling 16 weeks. The summer semester extends for 8 weeks.
