The vacant position: Laboratory technician/ prosector (Human anatomy)

Grade: Specialist A (T5)

➤ **The candidate will be responsible for the following tasks:**

1. Producing detailed and accurate anatomical prosections, both routine and specialized.
2. Arranging with academic staff and workshops organizers to determine particular requirements and precise details for prosection work.
3. Preparing prosections for plastination and wet display for gross anatomy practicals.
4. Maintaining the supply of prosections and replacing them as required when worn or damaged.
5. Supervising postgraduate students during the routine dissection sessions and providing the required technical expertise.
6. Locating and preparing the prosections required for practical exams.
7. Assisting the current lab technicians in the routine inspection and maintenance of the stored cadavers and specimens, in addition to the day-to-day running of the dissection room, museum and histology lab.
8. Keeping the department superintendent informed of any problems with the condition of prosections and making suggestions as to the use or disposal of damaged/worn prosections.
9. Assisting with the removal of body parts for research and teaching and associated labelling, identifying pieces that are best suited to prosection requirements.

➤ **Criteria and qualifications as per the Medical By-Laws (in the attached document), and the following additional requirements:**

1. Minimum 6 years' experience of working in anatomy facility with involvement in dissection, prosection, and preservation of anatomical specimens.
2. Strong knowledge of human anatomy is required.
3. Fine dissection skills and attention to detail during dissection.
4. Experience in embalming techniques and the preparation of anatomy museum specimens.
5. Experience and skills in histological techniques is preferable.
6. Experience in demonstrating anatomy to students in English is preferable.

7. Interpersonal skills, effective oral and written communication skills, strong organizational skills, accurate record keeping, ability to work independently and in a team environment.
 8. Sound computer skills.
 9. Physically fit to keep up with the physically demanding nature of work in an anatomy facility.
