RULES & CRITERIA for SUMMER SEMESTER

Phase 1 Students of the MD Program

- ❖ Students are eligible for Summer if the below criteria are gathered or met
 1. MD Phase 1 - Degree Plan courses include in Summer
(i.e. MEDI2100, MEDI2106, MEDI2107, MEDI2108, MEDI2109)
 2. Expected to graduate or complete Phase 1 by the end of the Summer
 3. Review the Summer Master Timetable for the availability of **University Electives & University Requirements** offered by other colleges
 4. Allowed to take only one course neither University Elective nor University Requirement
 5. Students who have the remaining 8 credits or below in Phase 1 are eligible
 6. 8 credits (3 courses) is the maximum number of credit hours allowed
 7. Please be aware of the following:
 - *Students on probation or who have failed 50% of courses in Spring are not allowed to register*
 - *Students who have withdrawn or postponed a course or have less load in Fall and Spring will be given less priority depending on the available seat*
 - *Withdrawing a summer course(s) after the Drop/Add period deletes the summer registration and courses will be recorded on the student's transcript as "W", "FW", or "F" in accordance with the academic regulations*

Biomedical Science Students (First Year)

- ❖ General Regulations for Summer Registration will be applied
 1. Available courses offered in the Summer based on students' Degree Plan
(i.e. MEDI2100, MEDI2107, MEDI2108, MEDI2109)
 2. **MEDI2106** course will be given to students who wish to transfer to the MD program
 3. MDLS5020 - Clinical Placement course is available for BMS graduating students
 4. Check the Summer Master Timetable for **University Electives & University Requirements** courses availability offered by other colleges
 5. Only one (1) University Elective or University Requirement is allowed
 6. The allowed maximum number of credits is 8 CR (2 *courses*) and a minimum of 5 CR
 7. Please note the following conditions
 - *Students on probation or who have failed 50% of courses in Spring are not allowed to register*
 - *Students who have withdrawn or postponed a course or have less load in Fall and Spring will be given less priority depending on the available seat*
 - *Exceptions to the above regulations are those students who need course(s) to graduate at the end of the summer semester (example: MDLS5020 course)*
 - *Withdrawing a summer course(s) after the Drop/Add period deletes the summer registration and courses will be recorded on the student's transcript as "W", "FW", or "F" in accordance with the academic regulations*
